As reported in a COK Press Release last fall, the Supplemental Poverty Measure provided by the Census Bureau identified that poverty among children had doubled from 2021 to 2022. These figures align with the increase COK has had to purchase clothing for PreK-5th, Middle School and Head Start students. Many of our orders come directly from the School Teachers, Nurses, Social Workers, and Homeless Liaisons trying to help the families. According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics consumer prices are up 3.5% since March of 2023.

As a result, COK purchasing costs for clothing have increased significantly over last year's numbers. Our Volunteers continue to work tirelessly to increase funding through our clothing drives, annual golf outing, generous grants, and grassroots fundraising. However, as we look toward the next school year our goals will be bigger to ensure our Sussex County students have an opportunity to achieve excellence no matter what their family's financial situation might be. As President Bob Blouin mentioned: "we're seeing a trend with orders received even before the school year starts while touching an increased number of children." Our approach is simple: Let Them Dress for Success.
